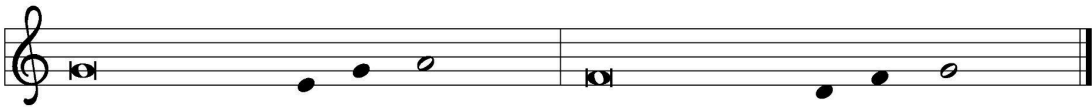

First Reading: Acts 3:12-19

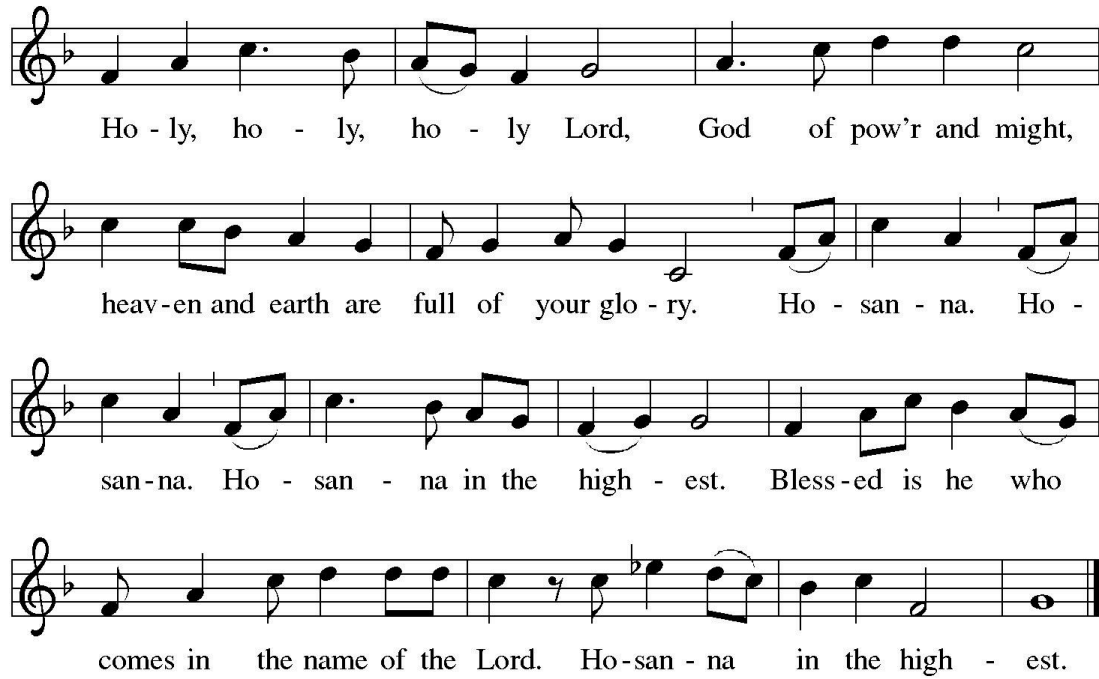
