THANKSGIVING AT THE TABLE;

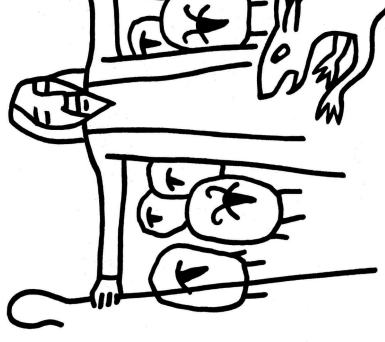
In the night in which he was betrayed,

forever and ever. Amen.

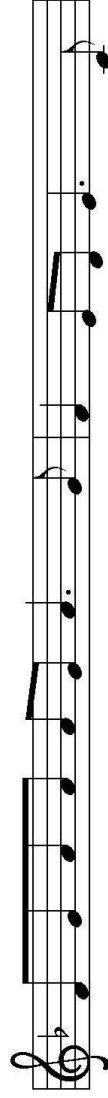

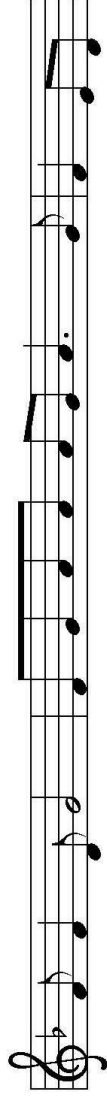

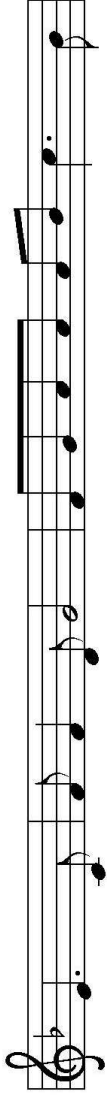
