SPIRITUAL RENEWAL

We could all stand to take a "day of rest" from commercialism during the holiday season to get some perspective on what makes us truly happy, whether we consider ourselves religious or not. One study looks at consumer shopping habits and compared them with participation in religious activities, and found that, among, women, money brings much less happiness than going to church. For those who attend them, religious services provide fellowship and often give people a greater sense of meaning to life, says Danny Cohen-Zada, a senior lecturer in the department of economics at Ben-Guion University of the Negev In Israel and lead author of the study. And he adds that although his study looked only at people who identified themselves as Christian, the relationship between religion and happiness would likely hold true for people of other faiths as well.



YOGA CHANGES


- 1. On January 1st, , the time change for Yoga will be 4:00PM instead of 6:00PM


